About Reward Zone Program for Schools

Reward Zone Program for Schools is a test that was created by the Wisconsin Stella WoLF Pack. The test began February 8, 2009 within the Wisconsin market and is now being tested through 9 mid west states. Those states are Wisconsin, Minnesota, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska and Kansas. We came to this test via feedback we received directly from you, our valued customers. Our stores conducted exit surveys with customers and found that you would like to see us do something more to help impact schools in which your children attend. Reward Zone Program for Schools is designed to allow you to donate your Reward Zone program points to a participating school of your choice. These schools can then use the Reward Zone reward certificates to purchase technology products for schools. Reward Zone Program for Schools is another means by which you can give back to your community. For all purchases that are donated, 2% is given back in Reward Zone reward certificates to each school.

Teach @15 Award

What is Teach@15? The Teach@15 Award program helps schools serving any grades 7-12 meet their technology needs. Teens (age 13-18) who are registered members on at15.com ("Members") can nominate their schools (depending on eligibility) to win a Teach@15 Award. Starting September 3, 2009, teen members can vote for a nomination once per day. Every 15 days, Best Buy will award 3 schools with Best Buy Gift Cards based on member votes. The school with the most votes will win \$1,500, second most votes wins \$1,000 and third most votes wins \$500.
