The Tri-City Schools Education Foundation Board supports educators by offering grants that benefit the students of the Tri-City School District.

The attached application has specific requirements. Applications that do not meet these requirements, late applications, and those to fund salaries including substitute teachers will not be considered. Grant applications that include students outside Tri-City Schools will also not be considered.

Applications will be considered on a competitive basis. A limited number of grants will be awarded. Winners of the Education Grants will be announced on October 19, 2009.

Projects selected for funding must expend the funds by the end of the 2009-10 school year. Grant Recipients are responsible for ordering materials through the school purchasing process.

Applicants who have received grant awards in the past must complete the required evaluation before they will be eligible for additional grant awards.

Applicants may be asked to appear before the Foundation Board to provide additional information about their grant application.

Equipment and non-consumable items provided by the foundation shall be available for use by other teachers when not in use by the grant recipient.

Applicants should make sure that funding is not available from other sources before submitting a grant application.

The Education Grant program is made possible through the generosity of many individuals and businesses that have donated to The Tri-City Schools Foundation. All projects and publicity must credit the Foundation.

The signatures of the grant applicant and school principal must be on the front page of the application.
