

## Community Trips

The Community Based Education program includes regular community trips as part of the curriculum. The purpose of participating in community trips is to develop everyday life skills beyond the classroom. Students practice many useful skills on these trips to develop independent functioning to the greatest degree possible. These skills include:

- Car and street safety
- Store safety and etiquette
- Locating and purchasing store items
- Learning and using proper money handling skills
- Restaurant social etiquette
- Ordering menu items
- Paying food bill
- Participating in recreational activities such as bowling, golf, swimming, roller skating, theatre, etc.

Several times a year all of the CBE classes within the SASSED District are invited to join a recreational group activity such as roller skating. Meeting with the other CBE students is a rewarding experience for everyone.
