

Class rules and consequences are as follows:

1. Listen when others are talking.
2. Follow directions the first time that they are given.
3. Keep hands, feet, and mouth to one's self. This is to include any unkind, rude or inappropriate language.
4. Work quietly and do not disturb others. Stay in your seat and quiet. Raise your hand, and avoid interrupting others.
5. Be kind and respectful to everyone.
6. Do your best work!

These rules parallel the student's homeroom class rules, which are posted in each area. We focus on maintaining a positive environment, which reinforces positive behavior, attitude, and choices. When students need to correct a behavior, they are given several reminders for relatively minor infractions. After several, (2), cues or reminders a warning is given. The student then corrects the behavior, or loses 5 minutes of noon recess for any continued infraction. Should problems continue, or should another problem arise, i.e., not working, the student may end up losing all of his/her noon recess. Any major problems, i.e. - physical aggression, verbal aggression, direct noncompliance, swearing, etc. results in automatic loss of all recesses, and possibly referral to the office.
