

Tri-City CUSD #1 Board Of Education Candidacy

Three seats on the Tri-City CUSD #1, Sangamon County, Board of Education will be up for election at the April 1, 2025 Consolidated Election. The seats open for nomination will include one seat from Mechanicsburg Township and two seats from the other townships. The three candidates elected will serve four-year terms expiring in April 2029.

Nomination papers for candidates are now available. The candidacy packets can be picked up at the Tri-City CUSD #1 District Office, or at the Sangamon County Clerk's Office.

On **Tuesday, August 20, 2024**, nominating petitions can be circulated for signature. The period for filing nominating papers runs from **November 12 through November 18, 2024**.

To be eligible to serve, a school board member must be, on the date of election:

- A citizen of the United States
- At least 18 years old
- A registered voter
- A resident of the State of Illinois and the school district for at least one year immediately preceding the election.

Elections are nonpartisan and board candidates do not indicate a political party affiliation. Candidates should be aware of financial conflict-of-interest limitations set forth in state law.
