Congressional Township/Residential Qualifications

To be compliant with ballot format 4, the successor need not be from the same township. Therefore, community members from any township are eligible.

Board Member's List of Qualifications

- Be a United States citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a resident of Illinois and the District for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment
- Be a registered voter
- Not be a child sex offender
- Not hold another incompatible public office
- Not have a prohibited interest in any contract with the District
- Not be a school trustee
- Not hold certain types of prohibited State or federal employment

Applicants must show familiarity with the Board's policies regarding general duties and responsibilities of a Board and a Board member, including fiduciary responsibilities, conflicts of interest, ethics and gift ban. The Board's policies are available on the district's website, <http://tricityschools.org>, select the tab "District Info Tab", select "Board of Education" and then select "District Policy Manual".

Term of Appointment

Appointment will be until the spring election of 2019.
